Come and join us for some down on the farm fun! Let your kids become Little Sprouts, during our eight week summer class series, as they discover the farm and all that it has to offer with hands-on farm projects, fresh snacks, and activities. Geared for children ages 3-10 years!

Classes will be held **every** Wednesday from June 17 to August 5. We will have two class sessions each Wednesday (9:00-10:30am and 11:00-12:30pm). All classes will meet under the pavilion at Flinchbaugh's Orchard and Farm Market. Check-in will begin 15 minutes prior to the start of each class.

Children MUST be pre-registered for EVERY class they attend!
Registration & Payment Due: June 15, 2015 (for early bird pricing of \$6 per class)

Admission Fee: \$8 per class per child. (pay only for those you attend)
OR pre-pay for the series by June 15 and receive our Early Bird discount – \$6 per class per child.

June 17th: What Does a Farmer Do?

Q: Can I register for Little Sprouts after June 15, 2015?

Q: Do I need to stay while my child participates in Little Sprouts?

A: We ask that a parent or guardian stay with children ages 3-6 during all classes. However, all parents are welcome to stay with their child!
