Q: How do I register my child for Little Sprouts?

Q: Can I register for Little Sprouts after June 13, 2016?

A: Yes, you can still register and pay after June 13th but each class will cost \$9 per child. We also ask that you please let us know as far in advance as possible that your child will be attending.

Q: Does my child need to bring anything with them to Little Sprouts?

A: Children are not required to bring anything with them, but we do encourage everyone to bring a water bottle and wear comfortable walking shoes (preferably sneakers)!

Q: Do I need to stay while my child participates in Little Sprouts?

A: We ask that a parent or guardian stay with children ages 3-6 during all classes. However, all parents are welcome to stay with their child!

Q: What if it rains on the day of Little Sprouts?

A: We will still have Little Sprouts! We will stay under the pavilion and complete our activities.
